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KNOW YOUR ENEMY

For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

Ephesians 6:12

Notice how the scripture does not say that we fight against our SPOUSE.

It's difficult at times to wrap our heads around the fact that our spouse is NOT our enemy!

However, we do have a true enemy that is doing all he can to come between us, our joy, and our marriage. He is the prince of darkness, the ruler of the world, his name is Satan.

When we recognize this fact and decide to fight the true enemy together, that is when victory will be achieved.

During the midst of our battle years ago, Raymond was treating me like the enemy.

The Lord however, gave me (Leslie) the grace to recognize that my husband was not my enemy, even if he treated me like his.

The Holy Spirit allowed me to separate the sinner (my husband) from the sin (the narcissism, angry outbursts, etc.). That although he was acting like my enemy, he was not the enemy!

Instead, it was the generational curses on his life, the strongholds he was battling, the lies he was entertaining from Satan, the wrong decisions he was making, those were the enemy and that was who I was fighting against – not my husband!

Ask the Lord to allow you to see your spouse the way He does. To open your eyes to see the true enemy, the one who comes to steal, kill, and destroy all that is good, including your marriage.

Ask the Lord to allow you to come together and fight from the victory you have already been given in Christ Jesus.

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

John 10:10 NKJV

PRAYER

Father God, thank you for Your Word that instructs us and reveals Your truth to us. Thank you for my husband/wife, for my ally. Lord give me eyes to see him/her as You do. Give me compassion, understanding, and revelation that he/she is a gift from You to fill the shortcomings in my life.

As we move through this marriage journey, open our eyes to the true enemy. Lord, when begin to treat each other as the enemy, stop us in our tracks, and turn our attention to the root of the conflict. Lord, show us how to work together to achieve the victory You have specifically for us.

If there is something I need to repent of to my husband/wife, give me the strength and words to ask for forgiveness. Soften both of our hearts Lord, first to You, then to each other.

Strategy #1

MY SPOUSE IS MY ALLY AND NOT MY ENEMY!

Two are better than one, Because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, For he has no one to help him up. Again, if two lie down together, they will keep warm; But how can one be warm alone? Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

KNOW YOUR WEAPONS

We use God's mighty weapons, not worldly weapons, to knock down the strongholds of human reasoning and to destroy false arguments.

2 Corinthians 10: NLT

Now that your sights are on the true enemy, what are the weapons you and your spouse can use together to receive your victory?

Does proper communication, intimacy, or trust come to mind? Well, yes, those are fantastic tools but they are not "God's mighty weapons!"

God's mighty weapons include:

- His Word & Holy Spirit
- Prayer & Worlship
- Forgiveness

As you each determine to use these weapons both individually and together, all those other tools will become easier to hone and incorporate into your lives.

But first, using God's mighty weapons will destroy the accusations, the strongholds, and bring unity, power, and allow the seemingly impossible to become possible.

These same weapons then became our weapons during reconciliation and even through today in our victory.

When you pray and worship, you are calling on the Lord to fight for you.

When you read His Word (the Bible) and are led by the Holy Spirit, you are changed, you are transformed into the image of Christ.

When you ask for forgiveness and extend forgiveness, you free yourself from bitterness, hurt, and anger. You also allow each other the space to become the man and woman that God created you to be.

Use God's mighty weapons, and "see the salvation of the Lord." In other words, experience your marriage like never before!

You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of the Lord, who is with you,

Then determine to put your sights on the true enemy, come together as one before God and allow Him to guide you as to how to address the issue together.

Surround yourself with a like-minded community. God did not create us to do life or marriage alone. This community should provide accountability, edification, encouragement, and opportunities to grow closer and stronger as a couple.
